**1. Chairman (Peter Brown)**

The Chairman wished all member clubs and the committee a enjoyable Christmas break and a peaceful New Year. He noted with disappointment the continued number of reports from games of misconduct by spectators, some of which had led to abandonments and misconduct charges. Unfortunately a number of these incidents had resulted in police involvement, which is particularly sad as these events had occurred at youth football matches. He urged that all member clubs review their approach to the use of RESPECT barriers at games and the teams in the younger age groups to assess whether the use of a Match Delegate would assist in improving touchline behaviour.

**2. General Secretary (Jonathan Brown)**
