c. Withdrawn Teams

The following teams unfortunately withdrew from the CYFL following the commencement of the playing season (during the month of October):-

Sundon Athletic Youth

The committee agreed that the above team should be fined £40, as per rule 14(B). (as this is the last team within the club to leave the CYFL, it was agreed that their deposit should be withheld to cover the fine). The Fixture Secretary confirmed as they had played less than 50% of their league fixtures for the season their record would be expunged.

d. Late Applications

The Secretary reported that a late application had been received from Bedford Santos (Under 11) to join the CYFL after the season had started. Following discussions with the club and the Bedfordshire Football Association, it was agreed that the club and team should be allowed to join the CYFL for the 2018 / 19 season and placed accordingly in one of the Under 11 Development Groups.

3. Fixture Secretary (Tony Gee)

a. Fixture Updates

Mr. Gee advised that fixture scheduling was proceeding well, apart from issues being caused by various County Cup fixtures. The Committee discussed the current phasing of fixtures for the Bedfordshire County Cups and the issuing of byes to selected teams; it was agreed that this is confusing for all and also lacks clarity about the reasons, especially where selected age groups are combined. The General Secretary was asked to write to the Bedfordshire Football Association to ask for views and clarity around the seeding process.

Mr. Gee recorded his apologies to Inspire Athletic (Under 11), who had several weeks without a game following the Under 11 Autumn Shield / Cup and restructuring of the Development Groups.

Mr. Gee also expressed concerns over the issues being caused by the Berks & Bucks County Cups, where their clubs are allowed to play fixtures on either Saturday or Sunday. CYFL clubs are reminded that if their players are dual registered with teams who play in different leagues on Saturday and their Saturday club chooses to play their County Cup game on a Sunday, the CYFL fixture will NOT be cancelled as a result.

b. Committee Pitch Walking

b. Referee Appointment Coverage Challenges

Mr. Desborough also reported the following to highlight some of the current challenges with regards to the appointment of referees to fixtures.

'We've recently run two referee courses with a total of 43 referees, 30 of which have put themselves down for Sunday's. Despite that, we have AM games uncovered this weekend. This is to highlight just how abysmal the availability on offer is at the moment.'

The Committee expressed their disappointment over the poor level of referee coverage at present, although it noted that the situation had improved during October, although the level of coverage was below that of previous seasons at this time. However it was noted that the challenges are County and Nationwide, as opposed to being specific to the CYFL.
